AN ACT

- Directing the Health Care Cost Containment Council to conduct a study relating to the feasibility of requiring all health
- insurance plans offered to State government employees to be
- part of a single trust fund for the provision of health insurance plans to the employees and for the council to
- report the study to the General Assembly and to the Governor.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. State health insurance plan study.
- 10 (a) Duty to conduct. -- The Health Care Cost Containment
- 11 Council shall conduct a study relating to the feasibility of
- 12 requiring all health insurance plans offered to State government
- 13 employees to be part of a single trust fund for the provision of
- 14 health insurance plans to the employees. The study shall include
- 15 the cost savings to be realized by the migration of multiple
- 16 health insurance plans to a single trust fund.
- 17 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, "State government
- 18 employees" or "employees" means persons who are employed by one
- 19 of the three branches of State government of the Commonwealth
- 20 and are not covered under a health insurance contract plan

- 1 negotiated through collective bargaining.
- 2 Section 2. Report.
- 3 The Health Care Cost Containment Council shall prepare and
- 4 transmit a report that includes the findings of the study
- 5 required under section 1 to the chairman of the Finance
- 6 Committee of the Senate and to the chairman of the Finance
- 7 Committee of the House of Representatives within six months of
- 8 the effective date of this section.
- 9 Section 3. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 30 days.
