Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 2 assault of law enforcement officer. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. Section 2702.1(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by 7 8 adding subsections to read: 9 § 2702.1. Assault of law enforcement officer. (a) Assault of a law enforcement officer in the first 10 degree. -- A person commits a felony of the first degree who 11 12 [attempts to cause or] intentionally or knowingly causes or_ 13 attempts to cause bodily injury to a law enforcement officer, 14 while in the performance of duty and with knowledge that the victim is a law enforcement officer, by discharging a firearm. 15

2	degree BY BODILY FLUID WITH COMMUNICABLE DISEASEA person <
3	commits a felony of the second FIRST degree if he intentionally <
4	or knowingly causes or attempts to cause a law enforcement
5	officer, while in the performance of his duty and with knowledge
6	that the victim is a law enforcement officer, to come into
7	<u>contact with blood, seminal fluid, saliva, urine or feces by</u>
8	throwing, tossing, spitting or expelling such fluid or material_
9	when, at the time of the offense, the person knew, had reason to
10	know, should have known or believed such fluid or material to
11	have been obtained from an individual, including the person
12	charged under this subsection, infected by a communicable
13	disease, including, but not limited to, human immunodeficiency
14	<u>virus (HIV) or hepatitis B.</u>
15	(a.2) Assault of law enforcement officer in the third degree <
16	BY BODILY FLUIDA person commits a felony of the third SECOND <
17	degree if he intentionally or knowingly causes or attempts to
18	cause a law enforcement officer, while in the performance of his
19	duty and with knowledge that the victim is a law enforcement
20	officer, to come into contact with blood, seminal fluid, saliva,
21	urine or feces by throwing, tossing, spitting or expelling such
22	<u>fluid or material.</u>
