6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 1307(f)(5) and (6) of Title 66 of the
9	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 1307. Sliding scale of rates; adjustments.

12	(f) Recovery of natural gas costs
13	* * *
14	(5) The commission, after hearing, shall determine the
15	portion of the company's natural gas distribution actual
16	natural gas costs in the previous 12-month period which meet
17	the standards set out in section 1318. The commission shall,
18	by order, direct each natural gas distribution company
19	subject to this subsection to refund to its customers gas
20	revenues collected pursuant to paragraph (2) which exceed the

1 amount of actual natural gas costs incurred consistent with 2 the standards in section 1318 and to recover from its 3 customers any amount by which the actual natural gas costs, which have been incurred consistent with the standards in 4 5 section 1318, exceed the revenues collected pursuant to paragraph (2). Absent good reason to the contrary, the 6 commission shall issue its order within six months following 7 8 the filing of the statement described in paragraph (3). 9 [Refunds to customers shall be made with interest, at the legal rate of interest plus two percent, during the period or 10 periods for which the commission orders refunds, and 11 12 recoveries from customers shall include interest at the legal 13 rate of interest: Provided, That nothing contained herein 14 shall limit the applicability of any defenses, principles or 15 doctrines which would prohibit the commission's inquiry into 16 any matters that were decided finally in the commission's 17 order issued under paragraph (2).] Refunds to customers shall 18 be made with and recoveries from customers shall include 19 interest at the prime rate for commercial borrowing in effect 20 60 days prior to the tariff filing made under paragraph (1) 21 and as reported in a publicly available source identified by 22 the commission or at an interest rate which may be 23 established by the commission by regulation. Nothing under 24 this paragraph shall limit the applicability of a defense, 25 principle or doctrine which would prohibit the commission's 26 inquiry into matters that were decided finally in the 27 commission's order issued under paragraph (2). 28 (6)[The commission shall require that customers 29 transferring from sales to transportation service be subject 30 to the over-or-under collection adjustment provided for in

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1	paragraph (5) and shall require further that customers
2	transferring from transportation service to sales service not
3	be subject to the over-or-under collection adjustment for an
4	appropriate period following either such transfer.] <u>If the</u>
5	natural gas distribution company's actual natural gas costs
6	exceed the revenues collected under paragraph (2) by more
7	than 10% in the previous 12-month period provided for under
8	paragraph (5) due to customers switching from sales service
9	to transportation service, the natural gas distribution
10	company shall have the right to fully recover the under-
11	collection through a nonbypassable charge. A request for
12	authorization to impose a nonbypassable charge shall be made
13	to the commission in a natural gas distribution company's
14	annual filing under this section or at the time of the
15	filing.

17	Section 2. Section 2205(c) of Title 66 is amended by adding
18	a paragraph to read:
19	§ 2205. Duties of natural gas distribution companies.

21	(c) Customer billing

23	(7) Natural gas distribution companies shall have the
24	right to recover on a full and current basis all prudent and
25	reasonable costs incurred to implement customer choice from
26	retail natural gas customers or other entities as determined
27	by the commission. Recovery from retail natural gas customers
28	shall be made pursuant to a reconcilable automatic adjustment
29	clause under section 1307 (relating to sliding scale of
30	<u>rates; adjustments).</u>

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- 2 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
