AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 1 P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of 2 unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay 7 contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the 8 payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; providing procedure and administrative details for the 10 determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 and the payment of such compensation; providing for 12 cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in compensation, 15 providing for compensation during quarantine or isolation. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 20 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is 21 amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 401.1. Compensation During Quarantine or Isolation. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this 23
- 24 act, an employe required by government order or a medical

- 1 practitioner to participate in a quarantine or isolation under
- 2 the act of April 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the
- 3 "Disease Prevention and Control Law of 1955," shall be eliqible
- 4 for unemployment compensation beginning on the first day of the
- 5 guarantine or isolation and for the duration of the guarantine
- 6 or isolation unless the following apply:
- 7 (1) the employe receives regular wages and compensation from
- 8 an employer for the duration of quarantine or isolation; or
- 9 (2) the employe is eligible to use sick leave or other paid
- 10 <u>leave or compensation provided by an employer for the duration</u>
- 11 of quarantine or isolation.
- 12 (b) The employe shall submit all necessary medical documents
- 13 or orders to the department and employer prior to receiving
- 14 benefits.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
