## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 15, 1945 (P.L.547, No.217), entitled "An act relating to the conservation of soil, water and related 2 natural resources and land use practices contributing to soil 3 wastage and soil erosion; providing for the organization of the various counties into conservation districts; the appointment of their officers and employes; and prescribing their powers and duties; creating the State Conservation 7 Commission in the Department of Environmental Resources and 8 9 fixing its powers and duties relative to the administration of this act; providing financial and legal assistance to such 10 conservation districts and the commission; and authorizing 11 county governing bodies to make appropriations thereto; 12 providing for disposition and operation of existing 13 districts; and repealing existing laws," providing for 14 legislative report. 15 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 The act of May 15, 1945 (P.L.547, No.217), known Section 1. as the Conservation District Law, is amended by adding a section 19 2.0 to read: 21 Section 14.1. Legislative Report. -- By March 1, 2020, and by

March 1 of each year thereafter, the commission shall submit a

report to the General Assembly. The report shall include, but

- 1 (1) An overview of the commission summarizing the
- 2 <u>commission's staffing, operations, program activities, sources</u>
- 3 of funding and a detailed accounting of how funding is used.
- 4 (2) The amount of money allocated to each conservation
- 5 district.
- 6 (3) The number, by each level, of certified commercial
- 7 manure haulers and brokers and the amount of certification and
- 8 examination fees collected.
- 9 (4) A project work summary, including program statistics, of
- 10 the dirt, gravel and low-volume road maintenance program under
- 11 75 Pa.C.S. § 9106 (relating to dirt, gravel and low-volume road
- 12 <u>maintenance</u>).
- 13 (5) A summary of activities under the leadership development
- 14 program established to train conservation district directors and
- 15 staff in Pennsylvania, including funding received and allocated.
- 16 (6) A summary of the nutrient and odor management program
- 17 under 3 Pa.C.S. Ch. 5 (relating to nutrient management and odor
- 18 management), including program statistics.
- 19 (7) A summary of the nutrient management and odor management
- 20 certification programs established under 3 Pa.C.S. § 508
- 21 (relating to nutrient management certification program and odor
- 22 management certification program), including numbers of persons
- 23 <u>certified by type and the amount of certification and</u>
- 24 examination fees collected.
- 25 (8) A summary of the projects receiving resource enhancement
- 26 and protection tax credits, along with the number of tax credits
- 27 <u>awarded</u>, <u>under Article XVII-E of the act of March 4</u>, 1971
- 28 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the "Tax Reform Code of 1971."
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
