AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, No.147), entitled
2 "An act providing for registration requirements for
3 telemarketers and for powers and duties of the Office of
4 Attorney General," further providing for unwanted telephone
5 solicitation calls prohibited.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 5.2(k) of the act of December 4, 1996
9 (P.L.911, No.147), known as the Telemarketer Registration Act,
10 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

11 Section 5.2. Unwanted telephone solicitation calls prohibited.

13 (k) Investigation, enforcement and reporting.--

14 * * *

15 (4) The Attorney General shall establish ongoing
16 communication with the Department of Aging in order to ensure
17 that consumers who are at least 60 years of age have access

1 to information regarding the prevention of potential patterns
2 of financial exploitation. The Attorney General shall
3 coordinate with the Secretary of Aging to determine the most
4 effective and efficient manner in which information shall be
5 shared, while ensuring strict adherence to rules of
6 confidentiality. The sharing of information shall exclude any
7 documents that may be deemed privileged or confidential.

8 * * *

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
