1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for application for driver's license or learner's permit, providing for issuance of driver's license or learner's permit to undocumented resident; establishing the Undocumented Resident Driver's License Services Administration Fund; and imposing penalties.

9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 1506 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
11	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
12	§ 1506. Application for driver's license or learner's permit.

14	(a.2) Undocumented resident applicationA person who has
15	resided in this Commonwealth for 90 days or more may apply for
16	an undocumented resident driver's license or learner's permit if
17	the person is ineligible to obtain a Social Security number and
18	unable to present documentation issued by the Federal Government
19	authorizing the person's lawful presence in the United States.

1	Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
2	<u>§ 1510.1. Issuance of driver's license or learner's permit to</u>
3	undocumented resident.
4	(a) Contents of applicationThe application for an
5	<u>undocumented resident driver's license or learner's permit under</u>
6	section 1506(a.2) (relating to application for driver's license
7	or learner's permit) shall include the applicant's full name and
8	date of birth. The department shall require identification
9	verification, which shall include a valid unexpired passport
10	from the applicant's country of citizenship, an unexpired
11	consular identification document or a consular report of birth
12	abroad.
13	(b) Consular identification documentA consular
14	identification document shall be accepted only for the purposes
15	of identification verification and shall not convey an
16	independent right to receive benefits outside of obtaining an
17	undocumented resident driver's license or learner's permit. The
18	department shall not accept a consular identification document
19	if the department reasonably believes that the consular
20	identification document is forged, fraudulent or altered or the
21	holder does not appear to be the same person on the consular
22	identification document. The consular identification document
23	shall contain all of the following:
24	(1) A physical description of the person, including sex,
25	height and eye color.
26	<u>(2) The person's signature.</u>
27	(3) Current residential address of the person. The
28	department shall require one of the following documents as
29	proof of the 90-day residency requirement for applicants
30	<u>under section 1506(a.2):</u>

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1	(i) Tax records.
2	<u>(ii) Lease agreements.</u>
3	<u>(iii) Mortgage documents.</u>
4	<u>(iv) W-2 form.</u>
5	(v) Current utility bills, including water, gas,
6	<u>electric or cable bills.</u>
7	(c) Issuance of consular identification documentsThe
8	issuance of a consular identification document shall comply with
9	all of the following:
10	(1) The foreign government issuing the consular
11	identification document shall require a person seeking a
12	consular identification document to obtain proof of
13	nationality, proof of identity and proof of residence in the
14	<u>consular district.</u>
15	(2) The foreign government shall include all of the
16	following security features in the consular identification
17	document:
18	(i) A unique identification number.
19	(ii) An optically variable feature, including a
20	hologram or color-shifting inks.
21	<u>(iii) An ultraviolet image.</u>
22	(iv) Encoded information.
23	(v) Machine readable technology.
24	<u>(vi) Micro printing.</u>
25	<u>(vii) Secure laminate.</u>
26	(viii) An integrated photograph and a signature.
27	(3) The consular identification document shall include
28	all of the following data:
29	(i) The name and address of the person to whom it is

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1	(ii) The date of issuance.
2	(iii) The date of expiration.
3	(iv) The name of the issuing consulate.
4	(v) An identification number.
5	(vi) An English translation of the data fields.
6	(4) The issuing consulate shall file with the department
7	the consular identification document and a certification
8	indicating compliance with procedures of this subsection.
9	(d) Scope of consular identification documentA consular
10	identification document shall not be accepted as identification
11	for registering to vote or obtaining a driver's license or
12	learner's permit other than an undocumented resident driver's
13	license or learner's permit. A consular identification document
14	shall not establish or indicate lawful United States immigration
15	status or a foreign national's right to be in the United States
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16	or remain in the United States.
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16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28	(e) Proof of identityAn undocumented resident driver's license or learner's permit shall not be accepted as proof of the holder's identity. The driver's license or permit shall contain a notice on its face, in capitalized letters, stating that the driver's license or learner's permit shall not be accepted as proof of identity and shall be valid only if the person is domiciled in this Commonwealth. Upon notice of a change of address from a driver to an out-of-State address, the department shall not renew the driver's license or learner's permit of the person until the person reestablishes residency in this Commonwealth as provided under section 1515(c)(2) (relating to notice of change of name or address). 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1	(f) Liability insuranceAn undocumented resident driver's
2	license or learner's permit shall be invalid if the holder is
3	unable to provide proof of liability insurance as required by
4	Chapter 17 (relating to financial responsibility) upon the
5	request of a law enforcement officer, in which case the holder
6	commits a violation of Chapter 17.
7	(g) Issuance of license or permitAn undocumented resident
8	driver's license or learner's permit shall be issued from a
9	central location after the department has verified the
10	information provided by the applicant.
11	(h) FeesAn undocumented resident driver's license and
12	learner's permit fee plus the cost of the photograph required in
13	section 1510(a) (relating to issuance and content of driver's
14	license) shall be as provided in section 1951 (relating to
15	driver's license and learner's permit).
16	(i) Undocumented Resident Driver's License Services
17	Administration FundThere shall be established in the State
18	Treasury a special fund to be known as the Undocumented Resident
19	Driver's License Services Administration Fund. The fees
20	collected from issuing undocumented resident drivers' licenses
21	and learners' permits shall be deposited into the fund. The fees
22	shall, subject to appropriation, be used by the department for
23	costs related to issuing the drivers' licenses and learners'
24	permits and other operational costs, including personnel,
25	facilities, computer programming and data transmission.
26	(j) RegulationsThe following shall apply:
27	(1) The department shall adopt regulations necessary to
28	effectuate the provisions of this section, including the
29	procedure for issuing undocumented resident drivers' licenses
30	and learners' permits.

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1	(2) Except as otherwise provided in this title or
2	administrative rule, a person issued an undocumented resident
3	driver's license or learner's permit shall be subject to the
4	provisions of this title and regulations issued by the
5	secretary to the same extent as a person issued a driver's
6	license or learner's permit, including, but not limited to,
7	the examination requirements under section 1508 (relating to
8	examination of applicant for driver's license) and the
9	mandatory insurance requirements and penalties specified
10	<u>under this title.</u>
11	(k) PenaltiesA violation of this section shall result in
12	the penalties and disposition of fines as provided in Chapter 65
13	(relating to penalties and disposition of fines).
14	(1) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "consular
15	identification document" means an official identification card
16	issued by a foreign government for the purpose of identifying a
17	foreign national who is living outside of the foreign country.
18	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
