7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
10	Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
11	§ 1143. Transparency of political subdivision authorities.
12	All authorities created by a political subdivision shall
13	maintain a publicly accessible Internet website which includes
14	the following:
15	(1) the name of each board member of the authority;
16	(2) the length and expiration date of the term to which
17	the board member was appointed;
18	(3) an email address which may be used to contact each
19	board member listed on the publicly accessible Internet

1	website of the authority;
2	(4) the name and office of the individual who appointed
3	the board member; and
4	(5) the publicly accessible Internet website of the
5	government entity that created the authority.
6	§ 5624. Transparency of municipal authority.
7	An authority shall maintain a publicly accessible Internet
8	website which includes the following:
9	(1) the name of each board member of the authority;
10	(2) the length and expiration date of the term to which
11	the board member was appointed;
12	(3) an email address which may be used to contact each
13	board member listed on the publicly accessible Internet
14	website of the board;
15	(4) the name of the municipality that appointed each
16	board member; and
17	(5) the publicly accessible Internet website of the
18	municipality that created the authority, or in cases of
19	authorities created by multiple municipalities, the publicly
20	accessible Internet website of each municipality that created
21	the authority.
22	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
