AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the first, second class A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; 3 amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws 4 relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by 5 counties, including authorizing imposition of an excise tax 6 7 on the rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and providing for regional renaissance initiatives," 8 in fiscal affairs, further providing for hotel room rental 9 tax in third through eighth class counties. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 1770.10(c) of the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended, 14 15 subsection (k) is amended by adding a definition and the section 16 is amended by adding a subsection to read: 17 Section 1770.10. Hotel Room Rental Tax in Third through 18 Eighth Class Counties. -- * * * 19 The treasurer of each county electing to impose the tax
- 20 authorized under this section shall collect the tax and deposit
- 21 the revenues received from the tax in a special fund established
- for that purpose. Subsequent to the deduction for administrative 22

- 1 costs established in subsection (i), the county shall distribute
- 2 to the recognized tourist promotion agency or EMS services
- 3 <u>within the county</u> all revenues received from the tax not later
- 4 than sixty days after receipt of the tax revenues.

- 6 (d.1) A county may, by ordinance, use revenues imposed by
- 7 the tax under subsection (a) to fund EMS services within the
- 8 county. A county may use up to one hundred per centum of the
- 9 <u>revenue or choose to split the revenue between a tourist</u>
- 10 promotion agency and EMS services.

- 12 (k) The following words and phrases when used in this
- 13 section shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection
- 14 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 * * *
- 16 "EMS services." A career, nonprofit or volunteer entity that
- 17 engages in the business or service of providing emergency
- 18 medical services to patients within this Commonwealth by
- 19 operating any of the following:
- 20 (1) An ambulance.
- 21 (2) An advanced life support squad vehicle.
- 22 (3) A basic life support squad vehicle.
- 23 (4) A quick response service.
- 24 (5) A special operations EMS service. This paragraph
- 25 includes, but is not limited to:
- 26 (i) a tactical EMS service;
- 27 (ii) a wilderness EMS service;
- 28 <u>(iii) a mass-gathering EMS service; and</u>
- (iv) an urban search and rescue EMS service.
- 30 (6) A vehicle or service which provides emergency medical

- 1 <u>services outside of a health care facility</u>, as prescribed by the
- 2 <u>Department of Health by regulation.</u>

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
