AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), entitled 1 "An act to preserve and improve the purity of the waters of 2 the Commonwealth for the protection of public health, animal 3 and aquatic life, and for industrial consumption, and recreation; empowering and directing the creation of 5 indebtedness or the issuing of non-debt revenue bonds by 6 political subdivisions to provide works to abate pollution; 7 providing protection of water supply and water quality; 8 9 providing for the jurisdiction of courts in the enforcement thereof; providing additional remedies for abating pollution 10 of waters; imposing certain penalties; repealing certain 11 acts; regulating discharges of sewage and industrial wastes; 12 regulating the operation of mines and regulating the impact 13 of mining upon water quality, supply and quantity; placing 14 responsibilities upon landowners and land occupiers and to 15 maintain primary jurisdiction over surface coal mining in 16 Pennsylvania, " in scope and purpose, further providing for 17 18 fences along streams.
- 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. Section 702 of the act of June 22, 1937
- 22 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law, is amended
- 23 to read:
- 24 Section 702. Fences along Streams. -- [No] An administrative
- 25 agency of the Commonwealth or [any political subdivision thereof

- 1 shall] a municipality may require any person to erect a fence
- 2 along a stream in a pasture or other field used for grazing of
- 3 farm livestock for the purpose of keeping farm livestock out of
- 4 the stream. An ordinance enacted by a municipality under this
- 5 paragraph shall include provisions for stream crossings in
- 6 <u>accordance with Department of Environmental Protection</u>
- 7 regulations and guidelines relating to stream crossings.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
