1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fees, further providing for fee for local use.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 1935(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
7	adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 1935. Fee for local use.

10	(d) DistributionMoney paid into the Fee for Local Use
11	Fund shall be distributed by the department to each
12	participating county in accordance with the amounts collected
13	from the county. [Funds] <u>As the county elects by ordinance,</u>
14	money payable to a county under this section [shall be] may be:
15	(1) added to [funds] money payable to the county under
16	section 9010(b) (relating to disposition and use of tax) and
17	shall be used by the county for transportation purposes [or
18	be] <u>;</u>

1	(2) allocated by the county in accordance with section
2	9010(c)[.] <u>; or</u>
3	(3) used for EMS services within the county.
4	(e) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "EMS
5	services" means a career, nonprofit or volunteer entity that
6	engages in the business or service of providing emergency
7	medical services to patients within this Commonwealth by
8	operating any of the following:
9	(1) An ambulance.
10	(2) An advanced life support squad vehicle.
11	(3) A basic life support squad vehicle.
12	(4) A quick response service.
13	(5) A special operations emergency medical service. This
14	paragraph includes, but is not limited to:
15	(i) a tactical EMS service;
16	(ii) a wilderness EMS service;
17	(iii) a mass-gathering EMS service; and
18	(iv) an urban search and rescue EMS service.
19	(6) A vehicle or service which provides emergency
20	medical services outside of a health care facility, as
21	prescribed by the Department of Health by regulation.
22	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
