## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 44 (Law and Justice) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for reduction of local

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 44 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 16 This chapter relates to reduction of local police services.
- 17 § 2502. Definitions.
- 18 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Commissioner." The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State
- 4 Police.
- 5 <u>"State Police." The Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
- 6 <u>§ 2503. Fee for reduction of local police services.</u>
- 7 (a) Reduction of local police services. -- If a municipality
- 8 reduces the municipality's budget allocation for police services
- 9 by 25% or more from the prior calendar year, the municipality
- 10 must pay to the Commonwealth an amount equal to the reduction in
- 11 the municipality's budget allocation for police services.
- 12 (b) Elimination of local police services. -- If a municipality
- 13 eliminates the municipality's police services from the prior
- 14 calendar year, the municipality must pay to the Commonwealth an
- 15 amount equal to the municipality's most recent police budget
- 16 allocation.
- 17 (c) Exemption. -- A municipality that exceeds the 25%
- 18 reduction level and demonstrates that the services maintained
- 19 <u>still meet or exceed the recommended policing levels per capita</u>
- 20 established by the commissioner may seek an exemption to the
- 21 fee, which may be granted by the commissioner.
- 22 § 2504. Allocation of money.
- 23 Money collected under section 2503 (relating to fee for
- 24 reduction of local police services) shall be deposited into the
- 25 General Fund and shall be used exclusively to defray the cost of
- 26 State Police operations.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023, or
- 28 immediately, whichever is later.
