## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, further providing
- for exemptions and special provisions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 2 2(C) of Article VIII be amended by adding a <--
- 9 subsection to read:
- 10 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

- 12 (C) (I) CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH, WHO <--
- 13 SERVED IN ANY WAR OR ARMED CONFLICT IN WHICH THE UNITED STATES
- 14 WAS ENGAGED AND WERE HONORABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER
- 15 HONORABLE CIRCUMSTANCES FROM ACTIVE SERVICE, SHALL BE EXEMPT
- 16 FROM THE PAYMENT OF ALL REAL PROPERTY TAXES UPON THE RESIDENCE

- 1 OCCUPIED BY THE SAID CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH
- 2 IMPOSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA OR ANY OF ITS
- 3 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IF, AS A RESULT OF MILITARY SERVICE, THEY
- 4 ARE BLIND, PARAPLEGIC OR DOUBLE OR QUADRUPLE AMPUTEES OR HAVE A
- 5 SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY DECLARED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 6 VETERANS ADMINISTRATION OR ITS SUCCESSOR TO BE A TOTAL OR 100%
- 7 PERMANENT DISABILITY, AND IF THE STATE VETERANS' COMMISSION
- 8 DETERMINES THAT SUCH PERSONS ARE IN NEED OF THE TAX EXEMPTIONS
- 9 GRANTED HEREIN. THIS EXEMPTION SHALL BE EXTENDED TO THE
- 10 UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSE UPON THE DEATH OF AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN
- 11 PROVIDED THAT THE STATE VETERANS' COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT
- 12 SUCH PERSON IS IN NEED OF THE EXEMPTION.
- 13 (II) The surviving spouse of any member of the armed <--
- 14 forces of the United States who was killed in action IN ANY WAR\_ <--
- 15 OR ARMED CONFLICT as determined by the United States Department
- 16 of Defense, or who died as a result of injuries received while
- 17 in active service IN ANY WAR OR ARMED CONFLICT, shall be exempt <--
- 18 from the payment of all real property taxes on the surviving
- 19 spouse's primary place of residence, without any restriction on
- 20 the spouse's relocating to another primary place of residence
- 21 and without any requirement that the spouse reside in this
- 22 Commonwealth at the time of death of the member of the armed
- 23 forces. The exemption shall cease if the surviving spouse
- 24 remarries and shall not be claimed thereafter.
- 25 SECTION 2. THE ADDITION OF SECTION 2(C)(II) OF ARTICLE VIII <--
- 26 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA SHALL APPLY TO THE SURVIVING
- 27 SPOUSE OF ANY MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES
- 28 WHO, ON OR AFTER THE RATIFICATION OF THIS CONSTITUTIONAL
- 29 AMENDMENT BY THE ELECTORS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH:
- 30 (1) WAS KILLED IN ACTION IN ANY WAR OR ARMED CONFLICT AS

- 1 DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE; OR
- 2 (2) DIED AS A RESULT OF INJURIES RECEIVED WHILE IN
- 3 ACTIVE SERVICE IN ANY WAR OR ARMED CONFLICT.
- 4 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . (a) Upon the first passage by the General <-
- 5 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 6 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 7 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 8 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 9 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 10 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 11 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 12 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 13 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 14 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 15 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 16 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 17 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 18 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 19 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 20 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 21 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 22 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 23 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 24 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 25 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 26 passed by the General Assembly.
