AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- further providing for days schools not to be kept open and
- 7 for additional holidays and vacations.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Sections 1502(a) and 1503 of the act of March 10,
- 11 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 12 are amended to read:
- 13 Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open. -- (a) Except
- 14 as provided in subsection (c), no school shall be kept open on
- 15 any Saturday for the purpose of ordinary instruction, except
- 16 when Monday is fixed by the board of school directors as the
- 17 weekly holiday, or on Sunday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July,
- 18 [Christmas, Thanksgiving,] <u>Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving</u>,
- 19 Christmas, the First of January and up to five additional days

- 1 designated as local holidays in the adopted school calendar by
- 2 the board of school directors as official local school district
- 3 holidays, nor shall any school be kept open in any district
- 4 during the time of holding the teachers' institute for such
- 5 district. The board of school directors may cancel any day
- 6 designated as a local holiday in the event of a weather
- 7 emergency or natural disaster.
- 8 * * *
- 9 Section 1503. Additional Holidays; Vacations. -- The board of
- 10 school directors in any district shall, by a majority vote,
- 11 decide which other holidays may be observed by special
- 12 exercises, and on which holidays, if any, the schools shall be
- 13 closed during the whole or part of the day. [The board of school
- 14 directors of each district shall require that each school within
- 15 such district observes Veterans' Day by special exercises.] The
- 16 board of school directors may provide for such vacations in its
- 17 district as it deems wise. No days on which the schools are
- 18 closed shall be counted as days taught.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
