AN ACT

Amending the act of May 26, 1947 (P.L.318, No.140), entitled "An act relating to the practice of public accounting; providing for the examination, education and experience requirements for certification of certified public accountants and for the licensing of certified public accountants, public accountants 5 and firms; requiring continuing education and peer review; 6 providing for the organization and ownership of firms and for 7 the procedures and grounds for discipline and reinstatement of licensees; prescribing the powers and duties of the State 9 Board of Accountancy and the Department of State; providing 10 for ownership of working papers and confidentiality; 11 regulating the professional responsibility of licensees; 12 defining unlawful acts and acts not unlawful; providing 13 penalties; and repealing existing laws," establishing a 14 continuing education pilot program for certified public 15 accountants assisting volunteer firefighter organizations. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. The act of May 26, 1947 (P.L.318, No.140), known 20 as the CPA Law, is amended by adding a section to read: 21 Section 8.10. Continuing Education Pilot Program for 22 Certified Public Accountants Assisting Volunteer Firefighter Organizations. -- (a) A continuing education pilot program for 23

certified public accountants assisting volunteer firefighter

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- 1 organizations is established. The pilot program shall expire
- 2 <u>after four years.</u>
- 3 (b) The following shall apply to the pilot program:
- 4 (1) A certified public accountant may earn up to forty hours
- 5 of the continuing education requirement under section 8.2(b).
- 6 (2) A certified public accountant may not be charged a
- 7 biennial renewal fee.
- 8 (3) Each hour earned may be used toward renewal of a license
- 9 and may not be used for reactivation of a license.
- 10 (4) A certified public accountant may only review the
- 11 financial statements and records of the volunteer firefighter
- 12 organization and may not perform auditing for the volunteer fire
- 13 <u>organization</u>.
- 14 (5) The pilot program shall be administered in accordance
- 15 with 49 Pa. Code § 11.71 (relating to responsibilities of CPE
- 16 program sponsor).
- 17 (6) Oversight of a certified public account shall be
- 18 conducted by a CPE program sponsor approved under 49 Pa. Code §
- 19 § 11.69a (relating to approval of CPE program sponsor).
- 20 (c) A certified public accountant must be a resident of this
- 21 Commonwealth in order to be eligible to participate in the pilot
- 22 program.
- 23 (d) A volunteer firefighter organization must be located in
- 24 this Commonwealth in order to be eligible to participate in the
- 25 pilot program.
- 26 (e) The following shall apply to liability:
- 27 <u>(1) Each chief elected officer of a volunteer firefighter</u>
- 28 organization, certified public accountant and CPE program
- 29 sponsor must sign a waiver of liability in order to participate
- 30 in the pilot program.

- 1 (2) A waiver under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall:
- 2 (i) Be considered as a contract among the signers.
- 3 (ii) Require that:
- 4 (A) The certified public accountant maintain confidentiality
- 5 concerning the volunteer firefighter organization, except for
- 6 <u>illegal activities</u>, and interact directly with the volunteer
- 7 <u>firefighter organization's chief elected officer.</u>
- 8 (B) The volunteer firefighter organization agree to give the
- 9 certified public accountant full access to the financial
- 10 statements and records of the volunteer firefighter organization
- 11 and the ability to report illegal activities the certified
- 12 <u>public accountant finds without being subject to liability for</u>
- 13 <u>civil damages.</u>
- 14 (C) The CPE program sponsor maintain confidentiality
- 15 concerning the volunteer firefighter organization and accept
- 16 responsibility for the certified public accountant's behavior
- 17 while interacting with the volunteer firefighter organization's
- 18 members and for the work the certified public accountant
- 19 performs.
- 20 (f) The following shall apply to procedure:
- 21 (1) A certified public accountant participating in the pilot
- 22 program:
- 23 (i) Shall be assigned by the CPE program sponsor to a
- 24 volunteer firefighter organization in the certified public
- 25 <u>accountant's area. The certified public accountant must review</u>
- 26 the financial statements or records of the volunteer firefighter
- 27 <u>organization in a manner as provided under 49 Pa. Code § 11.68</u>
- 28 (relating to documentation of CPE hours).
- 29 <u>(ii) Must document and submit the certified public</u>
- 30 accountant's hours to the CPE program sponsor after every

- 1 <u>session with the volunteer firefighter organization.</u>
- 2 (iii) Must, within seven days of the end of the second year
- 3 of the pilot program, submit a report to the certified public
- 4 <u>accountant's CPE program sponsor consisting of each accounting</u>
- 5 problem faced and each solution proposed to the volunteer
- 6 firefighter organization.
- 7 (2) A volunteer firefighter organization must submit to the
- 8 CPE program sponsor the volunteer firefighter organization's
- 9 <u>name</u>, address and telephone number in a letter indicating that
- 10 the volunteer firefighter organization is interested in
- 11 participating in the pilot program.
- 12 (3) A volunteer firefighter organization's chief elected
- 13 <u>officer must submit to the CPE program sponsor an evaluation of</u>
- 14 the certified public accountant's service. The CPE program
- 15 sponsor shall send a copy of the evaluation to the board for use
- 16 in the pilot program's overall evaluation.
- 17 (q) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 18 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 19 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 20 "Volunteer firefighter organization." A nonprofit chartered
- 21 corporation, association or organization located in this
- 22 Commonwealth which provides fire protection services and which
- 23 may offer other voluntary emergency services within this
- 24 Commonwealth. Voluntary emergency services provided by a
- 25 <u>volunteer fire company may include voluntary ambulance and</u>
- 26 voluntary rescue services.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
