8	§ 3208.1. Commonwealth interference prohibited.
9	(a) Methods of contraceptionThe Commonwealth shall not
10	interfere with the use of medically appropriate methods of
11	contraception or the manner in which medically appropriate
12	methods of contraception are provided.
13	(b) Other interferenceNotwithstanding any provision of
14	this title or any other law or regulation, the Commonwealth
15	shall not interfere with the right of an individual to choose or
16	<u>obtain an abortion if:</u>
17	(1) the individual's pregnancy has not progressed beyond
18	<u>24 weeks; or</u>

- 1 (2) the individual's physician reasonably believes that
- 2 <u>an abortion at any point beyond 24 weeks of pregnancy is</u>
- 3 <u>necessary to prevent the death of the individual or the</u>

4 <u>substantial and irreversible impairment of a major bodily</u>

- 5 <u>function of the individual.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
