## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in abortion, further providing for 2 medical consultation and judgment. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 3204 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 3204. Medical consultation and judgment. \* \* \* 9 10 (b.1) Pain relief medication. -- No abortion shall be performed without providing pain relief medication to the unborn 11 child who is more than 15 weeks' gestational age prior to the 12 abortion procedure unless: 13 14 (1) the physician has prior knowledge of an adverse 15 reaction to pain relief medication by the pregnant woman; or 16 (2) there is a medical emergency where there is insufficient time to provide pain relief medication before 17 the abortion is performed.

- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
