AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 453
2 over the Little Juniata River, Tyrone Township, Blair County,
3 as the Robert E. Gensimore Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Robert E. Gensimore Bridge.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) Robert E. Gensimore, a foreman for Blair District 9
10 of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, lost his
11 life in the line of duty on February 17, 2018.

12 (2) A resident of Spruce Creek, Gensimore was a 1991
13 graduate of Juniata Valley High School and served for 27
14 years as a member of the Warriors Mark-Franklin Volunteer
15 Fire Company.

16 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on Pennsylvania Route
17 453 in Tyrone Township, Blair County, over the Little Juniata

1 River, is designated the Robert E. Gensimore Memorial Bridge.

2 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
3 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
4 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

5 Section 2. Effective date.

6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
