- Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in service and facilities, providing
- for electricity supplied to seasonal businesses. 3
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 6
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7
- § 1512. Electricity supplied to seasonal businesses. 8
- (a) Limitation on charges. -- If a customer of a seasonal 9
- 10 business has not requested that electric service be disconnected
- during any period of nonuse of the seasonal business and there 11
- is no usage of the electric service during that period, a public 12
- utility supplying electric service to the customer may not 1.3
- 14 impose a monthly fee during the period of nonuse that exceeds
- 15 \$25 per month.
- (b) Definition. -- For purposes of this section, "seasonal 16
- business" means a campground, ski resort, amusement park, fair 17
- ground, hunting camp, golf course, recreational park, community 18

- 1 pool, sport complex or water park.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
