AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting a county, city or school district from levying,
- assessing or collecting a tax on real property; and repealing
- provisions relating to taxes on real property.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Property Tax
- 8 Elimination Act.
- 9 Section 2. Real property tax elimination.
- 10 A county, city or school district may not levy, assess or
- 11 collect a tax on real property on or after July 1, 2018.
- 12 Section 3. Repeals.
- 13 (a) Intent.--The General Assembly declares that the repeals
- 14 under subsection (b) are necessary to effectuate this act.
- 15 (b) Provisions. -- The following acts and parts of acts are
- 16 repealed:
- 17 (1) Section 631 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 18 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is repealed.
- 19 (2) Any provision of the Public School Code of 1949 and

- of any other law relating to the authority of a school
- 2 district to levy, assess and collect a tax on real property
- 3 and the power of a city of the first class to levy, assess
- 4 and collect a tax on real property.
- 5 (3) Any provision of the Public School Code of 1949 and
- 6 any other law relating to debt is repealed to the extent that
- 7 it is inconsistent with this act.
- 8 (4) Any provision of the Public School Code of 1949 and
- 9 any home rule charter adopted under the Public School Code of
- 10 1949 is repealed insofar as it is inconsistent with this act.
- 11 (5) Any provision of the act of August 9, 1963 (P.L.643,
- 12 No.341), known as the First Class City Public Education Home
- 13 Rule Act, and any home rule school district charter adopted
- 14 under the First Class City Public Education Home Rule Act is
- 15 repealed insofar as it is inconsistent with this act.
- 16 (6) Any provision of the act of June 27, 2006 (1st
- 17 Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act,
- is repealed to the extent that it is inconsistent with this
- 19 act.
- 20 (7) All acts and parts of acts that are inconsistent
- 21 with this act are repealed to the extent of such
- 22 inconsistency.
- 23 Section 4. Effective date.
- 24 This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
