AN ACT

1 2	Authorizing public school districts to implement senior local tax reduction incentive volunteer exchange programs.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Short title.
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Senior Tax
7	Reduction Incentive Volunteer Exchange Program Act.
8	Section 2. Legislative intent.
9	It is the intent of the General Assembly to authorize all
10	public school districts in this Commonwealth to establish a
11	program to allow older residents to volunteer in the school
12	district and receive a real property tax credit in exchange for
13	their volunteer service. While there are school districts across
14	this Commonwealth that provide certain property tax relief to
15	seniors, the purpose of this act is to grant explicit
16	legislative authorization to allow all school districts to

implement such programs. It has been shown that senior tax 1 2 reduction volunteer exchange programs provide much needed relief 3 to senior citizens, who often struggle to meet the rising cost of property taxes, and helps schools meet an increasing demand 4 for a variety of human skills and services. Both senior citizens 5 and children benefit from establishing a relationship in which 6 7 they interact with one another in a positive learning 8 environment.

9 Section 3. Definitions.

10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:

13 "Department." The Department of Aging of the Commonwealth.
14 "Participant." A person at least 60 years of age who has
15 been a resident of this Commonwealth for at least 90 days, owns
16 real property located in a participating school district and
17 participates in the school district's program.

18 "Program." A Senior Tax Reduction Incentive Volunteer19 Exchange Program authorized by this act.

20 Section 4. Program guidelines.

(a) Local guidelines.--School districts may establish a
program and may promulgate specific guidelines regarding the
program, including the acceptance of participants. The
guidelines shall include a criminal background check for each
individual seeking to participate in the program.

(b) Value of tax credit.--The rate of real property tax credit for senior volunteers shall be established by the school district and may not exceed the total amount of real property taxes that are owed.

30 (c) Services.--The types of services that participants 20150HB0791PN3024 - 2 - provide through a program must enhance the academic program of
 the school district.

3 Section 5. Personal income tax levied by the Commonwealth.

A real property tax credit received by a participant shall not be subject to the tax imposed under Article III of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971.

8 Section 6. Existing job positions.

9 A program shall not replace or supplant existing job 10 positions in a school district.

11 Section 7. Funding.

School districts may seek private and public funding sources 13 to support a program.

14 Section 8. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect immediately.
