## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled "An act relating to the practice of professional nursing; 2 providing for the licensing of nurses and for the revocation 3 and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for 4 their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such 5 licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing 6 penalties and repealing certain laws," providing for performance of reproductive health services on non-8 Commonwealth residents. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. The act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended by adding a section 13 14 to read: 15 Section 13.1. Performance of Reproductive Health Services on 16 Non-Commonwealth Residents. -- (a) The following shall apply: 17 (1) The performance, assistance in performance, 18 recommendation or provision of reproductive health services by a licensee acting within the licensee's scope of practice under 19

this act for a patient who resides in a jurisdiction outside of

- 1 this Commonwealth where the performance, assistance in
- 2 performance, recommendation or provision of the reproductive
- 3 health services is illegal shall not, by itself, be considered
- 4 any of the following:
- 5 (i) A violation of this act.
- 6 (ii) Grounds for refusal, suspension or revocation of a
- 7 license under this act.
- 8 (iii) Grounds for any other penalty regarding a license
- 9 under this act.
- 10 (iv) Grounds for a disciplinary action of the licensee under
- 11 this act or any other State law, regulation or rule governing
- 12 the licensure, certification or authorization of the licensee.
- 13 (2) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to expand
- 14 the scope of practice of a licensee under this act or authorize
- 15 the licensee to act outside of the licensee's scope of practice
- 16 under this act.
- 17 (b) An applicant seeking licensure, certification or
- 18 authorization under this act who has been subject to a
- 19 disciplinary action by a duly authorized professional
- 20 disciplinary agency of a jurisdiction outside of this
- 21 Commonwealth solely on the basis of having performed, assisted
- 22 in performing, recommended or provided reproductive health
- 23 services shall not be denied the licensure, certification or
- 24 authorization unless the Board determines that the action would
- 25 have constituted a violation of this act in this Commonwealth.
- 26 Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as prohibiting the
- 27 Board from evaluating the conduct of the applicant and making a
- 28 determination regarding whether the applicant is qualified to be
- 29 licensed, certified or authorized under this act.
- 30 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:
- 2 "Reproductive health services" means any of the following:
- 3 (1) Abortion as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3203 (relating to
- 4 <u>definitions</u>).
- 5 (2) Emergency contraception, including one or more
- 6 prescription drugs used separately or in combination to be
- 7 <u>administered or self-administered by a patient to prevent</u>
- 8 pregnancy within a medically recommended amount of time after
- 9 sexual intercourse and dispensed for that purpose in accordance
- 10 with professional standards of practice and determined by the
- 11 United States Food and Drug Administration to be safe.
- 12 (3) Medical, surgical, counseling or referral services
- 13 relating to the human reproductive system, including services
- 14 relating to pregnancy, the prevention of pregnancy or the
- 15 termination of a pregnancy.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
