A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for terms of members.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:
- 8 § 3. Terms of members.
- 9 (a) Senators shall be elected for the term of four years and
- 10 Representatives for the term of two years. <u>Senators shall not be</u>
- 11 eligible for election to more than three consecutive full terms
- 12 of office. Representatives shall not be eligible for election to
- 13 more than six consecutive full terms of office.
- 14 (b) A Senator who has served the maximum number of
- 15 consecutive full terms may become a candidate for election to
- 16 the Senate at an election held not fewer than four years after
- 17 completion of the Senator's third consecutive full term of

- 1 office. A Representative who has served the maximum number of
- 2 consecutive full terms may become a candidate for election to
- 3 the House of Representatives at an election held not fewer than
- 4 two years after completion of the Representative's sixth
- 5 consecutive full term of office.
- 6 Section 2. Service in the General Assembly, whether the
- 7 service constitutes a full term of office or a partial term of
- 8 office, performed prior to the approval of the amendment of
- 9 section 3 of Article II of the Constitution of Pennsylvania by
- 10 the electorate shall not be considered in determining the
- 11 maximum number of consecutive full terms a Senator or
- 12 Representative may serve or in determining eligibility of a
- 13 Senator or Representative for election.
- 14 Section 3. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 15 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 16 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 17 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 18 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 19 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 20 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 21 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 22 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 23 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 24 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 25 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 26 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 27 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 28 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 29 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 30 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment

- 1 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 2 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 3 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 4 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 5 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 6 passed by the General Assembly.
