 further providing for refusal, suspension or revocation of
 license and grounds.

- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 16 of the act of March 2, 1956 (1955
- 10 P.L.1211, No.376), known as the Practical Nurse Law, is amended
- 11 by adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 16. Refusal, Suspension or Revocation of License;
- 13 Grounds.--* * *
- 14 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, if the
- 15 <u>licensee is convicted of an offense under section 13(a)(12) of</u>
- 16 the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The
- 17 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act," or a
- 18 substantially similar offense in another state, the board shall
- 19 permanently revoke the license of the licensee.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
