AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special
3 plates for recipients of Borinqueneers Congressional Gold
4 Medal.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1368.4. Special plates for recipients of Borinqueneers
10 Congressional Gold Medal.

11 (a) Issuance.--Upon application of a person who is a
12 recipient of the Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal,
13 accompanied by a fee of ~~\$22~~ \$26 which shall be in addition to <--
14 the annual registration fee and any documentation the department
15 requires, the department shall issue to the person a special
16 registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as
17 belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Borinqueneers
18 Congressional Gold Medal.

1 (b) Limitation.--A special registration plate under this  
2 section may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a  
3 registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

4 (c) Design.--The department shall design and produce the  
5 special registration plate under this section to display the  
6 Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal emblem and the words  
7 "Borinqueneers Congressional Gold Medal" at the bottom of each  
8 plate. Each special registration plate under this section that  
9 is not personalized shall also include the letter "B" as a  
10 prefix or suffix to the numerals on the special registration  
11 plate.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in ~~60~~ 120 days.
