AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto, " in State System of Higher Education, further providing for project contracts. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2003-A.1(a) and (d) of the act of March 9
- 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 10
- 1949, amended July 11, 1990 (P.L.424, No.103), are amended and 11
- the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 12
- 13 Section 2003-A.1. Project Contracts. -- (a) The State System
- 14 of Higher Education is hereby authorized to execute and
- administer contracts for construction, repair, renovation and 15
- 16 maintenance projects within the meaning of section 2401.1 of the
- 17 act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The
- Administrative Code of 1929," including all aspects of project 18
- management, design and construction and legal and administrative 19
- services related to and necessary for the completion of such 20

- 1 projects[, except capital projects which are funded by
- 2 Commonwealth general obligation bonds, capital appropriations or
- 3 pursuant to Article XVI-B of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343,
- 4 No.176), known as "The Fiscal Code," unless delegated by the
- 5 Department of General Services to the system].
- 6 (a.1) Capital projects that are funded by Commonwealth
- 7 general obligation bonds, capital appropriations or pursuant to
- 8 Article XIX-B of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known
- 9 <u>as the "Tax Reform Code of 1971," may be undertaken pursuant to</u>
- 10 <u>subsection</u> (a) where the system provides the Department of
- 11 <u>General Services with written notice of the system's management</u>
- 12 of the projects. Otherwise, responsibility for the projects
- 13 shall remain with the Department of General Services.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (d) The power and authority granted by this section [shall
- 16 not] <u>may</u> be exercised by the system, the board or an institution
- 17 for a project to modify, repair or renovate any facility erected
- 18 by the Department of General Services [unless] when prior
- 19 written notice setting forth the nature, scope, extent and
- 20 description of such project has been given to the Department of
- 21 General Services.
