AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing for exemption from Keystone Exams ASSESSMENT. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: 12 Section 121.1. Exemption from Keystone Exams ASSESSMENT. --(a) Within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date 13 of this section, each governing authority of a school entity 14 15 shall meet and determine if the school entity shall WHETHER TO 16 ADOPT A POLICY TO excuse a student from Keystone Exam testing 17 ASSESSMENT if the student's parent or quardian submits an <-objection based on philosophical grounds in writing to school 18

- 1 (b) If a governing authority of a school entity fails to
- 2 meet or make a determination as prescribed under subsection (a), <--
- 3 the school entity shall excuse a student from Keystone Exam <--
- 4 <u>testing ASSESSMENT if the student's parent or guardian submits</u> <--
- 5 <u>an objection based on philosophical grounds in writing to school</u>
- 6 officials.
- 7 (c) If a school entity adopts a policy allowing for excusal
- 8 from Keystone Exam testing ASSESSMENT based on philosophical
- 9 grounds under subsection (a), or if the school entity fails to
- 10 <u>meet or make a determination within the prescribed one hundred</u> <--
- 11 eighty (180) days and the default applies under subsection (b),
- 12 the following shall apply:
- 13 (1) A student shall not be given negative consequences,
- 14 <u>including</u>, <u>BUT NOT LIMITED TO</u>, the denial of a high school <--
- 15 <u>diploma</u>, based solely on the student's parent or guardian
- 16 utilizing the provisions under subsection (a) or (b).
- 17 (2) A school entity, including, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, the <--
- 18 administration, chief school officer, temporary professional
- 19 employes and, professional employes AND OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYES, <
- 20 may not:
- 21 (i) solicit a student or student's parent or quardian to
- 22 utilize the provisions under subsection (a) or (b); or
- 23 <u>(ii) be penalized for a student's parent or guardian</u>
- 24 utilizing the provisions under subsection (a) or (b).
- 25 (3) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PROHIBIT A SCHOOL ENTITY, <--
- 26 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE ADMINISTRATION, CHIEF SCHOOL
- 27 OFFICER, TEMPORARY PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYES, PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYES
- 28 AND OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYES, FROM COMMUNICATING WITH STUDENTS,
- 29 PARENTS OR GUARDIANS REGARDING THE UTILIZATION OF THE PROVISIONS
- 30 <u>UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) WHICH ARE NOT INTENDED TO SOLICIT</u>

- 1 SUCH UTILIZATION.
- 2 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 3 shall have the meanings given to them in the subsection unless
- 4 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 5 "ASSESSMENT." ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- 6 (1) THE PENNSYLVANIA SYSTEM OF SCHOOL ASSESSMENT TEST.
- 7 (2) THE KEYSTONE EXAM.
- 8 (3) A TEST ESTABLISHED BY STATUTE OR ESTABLISHED OR APPROVED
- 9 BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO COMPLY WITH:
- 10 (I) SECTION 2603-B;
- 11 <u>(II) SECTION 2604-B;</u>
- 12 (III) 22 PA. CODE § 4.51 (RELATING TO STATE ASSESSMENT
- 13 SYSTEM); OR
- 14 (IV) THE EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT (PUBLIC LAW 114-95, 129
- 15 STAT. 1802).
- 16 "Governing authority." A local board of school directors, or
- 17 the equivalent, of a school entity.
- 18 "School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, joint
- 19 school, area vocational-technical school, charter school,
- 20 regional charter school or cyber charter school.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
