AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 providing for waiver to purchase diapers or menstrual hygiene
- 5 products.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 9 as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 10 read:
- 11 Section 438. Waiver to Purchase Diapers or Menstrual Hygiene
- 12 Products. -- If the Food and Nutrition Service of the United
- 13 States Department of Agriculture creates and makes available to
- 14 the states a waiver permitting recipients of benefits provided
- 15 under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or
- 16 the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants
- 17 and Children (WIC) to use their benefits to purchase diapers or

- 1 menstrual hygiene products, such as tampons, sanitary napkins or
- 2 <u>feminine wipes</u>, the department shall apply for the waiver. If
- 3 the United States Department of Agriculture approves the
- 4 <u>department's waiver application, the department shall adopt</u>
- 5 <u>rules and make other changes as necessary to implement the</u>
- 6 <u>approved waiver.</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
