## AN ACT

Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in employees, further providing for 2 powers and duties of commission. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 2164(8) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 2164. Powers and duties of commission. 8 9 The powers and duties of the commission shall be as follows: 10 \* \* \* 11 To require minimum standards for physical fitness, 12 psychological evaluation and education as prerequisites to 13 employment as a police officer. The minimum standards shall <--14 require an applicant for certification to 15 the 30th percentile of the Cooper standards, which coincides 16 with the 30th percentile of the general population, for each 17 required evaluation to be eligible for employment as a police

officer. A school may not enroll an individual into a recruit

1	training program certified by the commission unless the
2	individual has obtained a score in the 15th percentile or
3	higher for the individual's age and gender as specified in
4	the Cooper standards for each required evaluation. THE <
5	FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
6	(I) THE MINIMUM PHYSICAL FITNESS STANDARDS SHALL
7	REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR CERTIFICATION TO SCORE NO LOWER
8	THAN THE 30TH PERCENTILE OF THE COOPER STANDARDS, WHICH
9	COINCIDES WITH THE 30TH PERCENTILE OF THE GENERAL
10	POPULATION, FOR EACH REQUIRED EVALUATION TO BE ELIGIBLE
11	FOR EMPLOYMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER. A SCHOOL MAY NOT
12	ENROLL AN INDIVIDUAL INTO A RECRUIT TRAINING PROGRAM
13	CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSION UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL HAS
14	OBTAINED A SCORE IN THE 15TH PERCENTILE OR HIGHER FOR THE
15	INDIVIDUAL'S AGE AND GENDER AS SPECIFIED IN THE COOPER
16	STANDARDS FOR EACH REQUIRED EVALUATION.
17	(II) THE MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL STANDARDS SHALL REQUIRE
18	AN APPLICANT TO DEMONSTRATE READING COMPREHENSION THROUGH
19	A READING COMPREHENSION TEST APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION,
20	WHICH SHALL TRANSMIT NOTICE OF APPROVED READING
21	COMPREHENSION TESTS TO THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU
22	FOR PUBLICATION IN THE NEXT AVAILABLE ISSUE OF THE
23	PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN AND ON THE COMMISSION'S PUBLICLY
24	ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE.
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26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
