## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rights and immunities, further providing for leaves of absence for certain government employees.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 4102 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 4102. Leaves of absence for certain government employees.
10	(a) Mandatory
11	[(1) All officers and employees of a political
12	subdivision, or its instrumentalities, who are members of the
13	Pennsylvania National Guard, shall be entitled to leave of
14	absence from their respective duties without loss of pay,
15	time or efficiency rating on all days during which they
16	shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, be

1 engaged in active State duty. All such officers and employees 2 shall, in addition, be entitled to leave of absence from 3 their respective duties without loss of pay, time or efficiency rating on all days not exceeding 15 days in any 4 5 one year during which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania National Guard or as members of any reserve 6 7 component of the armed forces of the United States, be 8 engaged in training or other military duty under orders 9 authorized by Federal or State law. All such officers and 10 employees shall, in addition, be entitled to unpaid leave of 11 absence from their respective duties without loss of 12 seniority or efficiency rating on all days in excess of 15 13 days per year during which they shall be engaged in training 14 or other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or 15 State law up to the maximum cumulative period authorized by 16 38 U.S.C. Ch. 43 (relating to employment and reemployment 17 rights of members of the uniformed services).

18 (2)All officers and employees of the Commonwealth or 19 its instrumentalities who are members of the Pennsylvania 20 National Guard shall be entitled to leave of absence from 21 their respective duties without loss of pay, time or 22 efficiency rating on all days during which they shall, as 23 members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, be engaged in 24 active State duty. All such officers and employees shall, in 25 addition, be entitled to leave of absence from their 26 respective duties without loss of pay, time or efficiency 27 rating on all days not exceeding 15 days in any one year 28 during which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania 29 National Guard or as members of any reserve component of the 30 armed forces of the United States, be engaged in training or

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1 other military duty under orders authorized by Federal or 2 State law. In addition, when such officers and employees 3 shall be ordered, involuntarily or under a Contingency Operations Temporary Tour of Active Duty (COTTAD) agreement 4 5 or voluntarily to serve in a combat zone or in response to a 6 domestic emergency, to active duty, other than active duty 7 for training, for a period of 30 or more consecutive days and 8 assigned to duties away from home station and when such duty 9 is ordered under 10 U.S.C. § 12301 (relating to Reserve 10 components generally), 12302 (relating to Ready Reserve) or 12304 (relating to Selected Reserve and certain Individual 11 12 Ready Reserve members; order to active duty other than during 13 war or national emergency) or 32 U.S.C. § 502(f) (relating to 14 required drills and field exercises), they shall be entitled 15 to up to 15 days of additional military leave of absence in 16 any one year without loss of pay, time and efficiency rating. 17 All such officers and employees shall, in addition, be 18 entitled to unpaid leave of absence from their respective 19 duties without loss of seniority or efficiency rating on all 20 days in excess of 30 days per year during which they shall be 21 engaged in training or other military duty under orders 22 authorized by Federal or State law up to the maximum 23 cumulative period authorized by 38 U.S.C. Ch. 43.]

24 (1) The following shall apply to paid military leaves of
25 absence:

(i) All officers and employees of the Commonwealth,
its political subdivisions or their instrumentalities
shall be entitled to paid military leaves of absence from
their respective duties without loss of pay or efficiency
rating, and without being required to use annual vacation

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1	time, as follows:
2	(A) On all days during which they shall, as
3	members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, be
4	engaged in active State duty under section 508
5	(relating to active duty for emergency).
6	(B) On all days not exceeding 15 consecutive or
7	nonconsecutive days in any one calendar year during <
8	which they shall, as members of the Pennsylvania
9	National Guard or as members of any reserve component
10	of the armed forces of the United States, be engaged
11	in training or other military duty under orders
12	authorized by Federal or State law.
13	(ii) All officers and employees of the Commonwealth
14	or its instrumentalities, except for officers and
15	employees of political subdivisions and their
16	instrumentalities, shall be entitled to up to 15 days of
17	paid military leave in addition to the leave under
18	<pre>subparagraph (i) in any one calendar year if the officers &lt;</pre>
19	and employees are ordered to active duty, other than
20	active duty for training, and all of the following apply:
21	(A) The duty is ordered for a period of at least
22	<u>30 consecutive days.</u>
23	(B) The duty is involuntary or is performed in a
24	zone of combat, in response to a domestic emergency
25	or pursuant to a contingency operations service
26	agreement.
27	(C) The duty is performed while the member is
28	deployed at least 50 miles away from both the
29	member's home duty station and place of residence.
30	(D) The duty is ordered under 10 U.S.C. § 12301

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1	(relating to Reserve components generally), 12302
2	(relating to Ready Reserve) or 12304 (relating to
3	Selected Reserve and certain Individual Ready Reserve
4	members; order to active duty other than during war
5	<u>or national emergency) or 32 U.S.C. § 502(f)</u>
6	(relating to required drills and field exercises).
7	(2) All officers and employees of the Commonwealth, a
8	political subdivision, or their instrumentalities shall, in
9	addition to the leave provided under this subsection, be
10	entitled to unpaid military leave of absence, up to the
11	maximum cumulative period authorized by 38 U.S.C. Ch. 43
12	(relating to employment and reemployment rights of members of
13	the uniformed services), from their respective duties without
14	loss of seniority or efficiency rating and without being
15	required to use annual vacation time on all days during
16	which:
17	(i) they are engaged in training or other military
18	duty under orders authorized by Federal or State law; and
19	(ii) they are not on paid military leave of absence.
20	(b) Discretionary <u>leave</u> The Commonwealth, its
21	instrumentalities and political subdivisions [thereof] and their
22	instrumentalities shall be authorized and permitted to provide
23	paid military leave or other compensation and/or continue
24	medical and other benefits to members of the Pennsylvania
25	National Guard and other reserve components of the United States
26	Armed Forces for days in excess of those provided in subsection
27	(a) when the member shall be engaged in training or other
28	military duty under orders authorized by Federal or State law.
29	(c) Return from leave <
30	(1) All officers and employees of the Commonwealth, its
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1	<u>political subdivisions or their instrumentalities shall not</u>	
2	be required to report back to the employer earlier than	
3	either of the following:	
4	(i) The beginning of the first full regularly	
5	scheduled work period on the first full calendar day	
6	following the completion of the period of military	
7	service.	
8	(ii) The expiration of eight hours after a period	
9	allowing for safe transportation from the place of that	
10	service to the employee's residence.	
11	(2) An officer or employee may voluntarily choose to	
12	return to duty within the period of time under paragraph (1).	
13	(d) Calculation of leave	
14	(1) Military leaves of absence shall be calculated or	
15	allotted in whole work days. Military leaves of absence may	
16	not be calculated or allotted on an hour by hour basis.	
17	(C) CALCULATION OF LEAVE	<
18	(1) AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS ON PAID OR UNPAID MILITARY LEAVE	
19	FOR A PERIOD ENCOMPASSING ONE ENTIRE CALENDAR DAY SHALL BE	
20	CHARGED WITH ONE DAY'S MILITARY LEAVE ON EACH WORKDAY	
21	NOTWITHSTANDING THE NUMBER OF HOURS ENCOMPASSED IN THE	
22	EMPLOYEE'S WORKDAY. AN EMPLOYEE ON PAID MILITARY LEAVE SHALL	
23	BE PAID FOR THE LEAVE BASED ON THE COMPENSATION DUE FOR THE	
24	LEAVE PERIOD.	
25	(2) An employee who is on paid or unpaid military leave	
26	of absence for a shift that extends into two consecutive	
27	calendar days shall be charged with only one day of military	
28	leave if the employee returns to work for the next regular	
29		
20	<u>shift.</u>	
30	<u>(3) As used in this subsection, the term "day" shall</u>	<

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- 1 <u>mean a calendar day of 24 hours' duration.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
