- hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1111. Reduction of sentence for minors.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 11 this chapter to the contrary, an individual who was under 18
- 12 years of age when he committed a crime for which he was
- sentenced to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of no less 13
- than ten years or who was sentenced to life imprisonment without 14
- 15 parole eligibility is subject to the jurisdiction of the
- 16 sentencing court for reduction of the sentence.
- 17 (b) Factors to be considered. -- In determining whether to
- reduce the sentence under this section, the sentencing court 18

- 1 <u>shall consider the following factors:</u>
- 2 (1) The individual's age and level of maturity at the
- 3 time of the offense.
- 4 (2) The individual's degree of participation in the
- 5 <u>offense.</u>
- 6 (3) The nature of the offense.
- 7 <u>(4) The severity of the offense.</u>
- 8 (5) The individual's prior juvenile or criminal history.
- 9 (6) The likelihood of the individual to commit further
- offenses.
- 11 (7) Other information considered relevant by the
- 12 <u>sentencing court.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
