8	Section 1. Section 3714 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
9	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
10	§ 3714. Careless driving.
11	(a) General ruleAny person who drives a vehicle in
12	careless disregard for the safety of persons or property is
13	guilty of careless driving, a summary offense.
14	(b) Unintentional deathIf the person who violates this
15	section unintentionally causes the death of another person as a
16	result of the violation, the person shall, upon conviction, be
17	sentenced to pay a fine of \$500.
18	(c) Serious bodily injuryIf the person who violates this
19	section unintentionally causes the serious bodily injury of

1	another person as a result of the violation, the person shall,	
2	upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$250.	
3	(c.1) Additional fine for distracted driver	
4	(1) Any person who violates this section and at the time	
5	of the violation is distracted by any task or item,	
6	including, but not limited to, any of the following, shall,	
7	in addition to any other penalty imposed, be sentenced to pay	
8	<u>a fine of \$50:</u>	
9	(i) An interactive wireless communications device.	
10	(ii) An electronic, electrical or mechanical device.	
11	(iii) A personal grooming device.	
12	<u>(iv) Food.</u>	
13	(v) Drink.	
14	(vi) Printed material.	
15	(2) The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to	
16	any person unless the person is convicted under subsection	
17	(a) for a violation that occurred at the same time. No costs	
18	as described under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1725.1 (relating to costs)	
19	may be imposed on account of an increased fine under this	
20	subsection. Application of this subsection does not	
21	constitute a moving violation.	
22	(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the	
23	contrary, fines collected under this subsection shall be paid	
24	to the Commonwealth for deposit into the Driver Distraction	
25	<u>Awareness Fund.</u>	
26	(c.2) ReportThe department shall submit to the General	
27	Assembly a report on the effects of subsection (c.1) by August

2	Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
3	<u>§ 3714.1. Driver Distraction Awareness Fund.</u>
4	(a) Fund establishedThe Driver Distraction Awareness Fund
5	is established in the Motor License Fund as a special restricted
6	receipts account. The fund shall consist of the fines deposited
7	under section 3714(c.1) (relating to careless driving), Federal
8	funds granted for careless driving prevention and any money
9	donated to the fund. The fund shall be used solely for the
10	purpose of the educational program established in subsection
11	(b). Money in the fund is appropriated to the department for the
12	purposes of this section.
13	(b) Educational programThe department shall establish an
14	educational program to begin immediately to alert the public to
15	the requirements and penalties under section 3714(c.1). The
16	program shall also encourage motorists to eliminate distractions
17	in the vehicle as a means of reducing the risk of harm to
18	themselves and others.

19 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
