AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for duties of
3 electric distribution companies.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2807(f)(3) of Title 66 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2807. Duties of electric distribution companies.

10 (f) Smart meter technology and time of use rates.--

11 * * *

12 (3) Electric distribution companies shall, with customer
13 consent, make available direct meter access and electronic
14 access to customer meter data to third parties, including
15 electric generation suppliers [and], providers of
16 conservation and load management services[.] and government <--

1 agencies. NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, CUSTOMER CONSENT
2 SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED WHEN:

3 (I) THE INFORMATION IS RELEASED TO COMPLY WITH A
4 SUBPOENA OR ORDER ISSUED BY A COURT OR REGULATORY AGENCY;

5 (II) THE INFORMATION IS RELEASED ON A CONFIDENTIAL
6 BASIS IN THE CONTEXT OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING
7 INVOLVING A CUSTOMER COMPLAINT;

8 (III) THE INFORMATION IS RELEASED IN AGGREGATED
9 FORM; OR

10 (IV) THERE IS AN EMERGENCY SITUATION INVOLVING AN
11 IMMINENT THREAT TO PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
