13	(2.3) An actor who is not engaged in a criminal
14	activity, who is not in illegal possession of a firearm and
15	who is attacked in any place where the actor would have a
16	duty to retreat under paragraph (2)(ii) $_{\it L}$ has no duty to
17	retreat and has the right to stand his ground and use force,
18	including deadly force, if all of the following subparagraphs

1 <u>apply</u>:

2 [the] The actor has a right to be in the place (i) 3 where he was attacked[;]. [the] The actor believes it is immediately (ii) 4 necessary to do so to protect himself against death, 5 serious bodily injury, kidnapping or sexual intercourse 6 7 by force or threat [; and]. 8 (iii) [the] Any of the following clauses apply: 9 (A) The person against whom the force is used 10 displays or otherwise uses [: (A)] a firearm or replica of a firearm as 11 12 defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 9712 (relating to sentences 13 for offenses committed with firearms) [; or]. 14 The person against whom the force is used (B) displays or otherwise uses any other weapon readily 15 16 or apparently capable of lethal use. (C) The person against whom the force is used 17 18 displays or possesses the physical power, stature or ability to kill or inflict serious bodily injury and 19 the actor believes it is necessary to protect himself 20 21 against death, serious bodily injury, kidnapping or 22 sexual intercourse by force or threat. 23 (D) The persons against whom the force is used 24 outnumber the actor such that he reasonably fears death, serious bodily injury, kidnapping or sexual 25 26 intercourse by force or threat. * * * 27 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
