## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in cruelty to animals, further providing for police animals.
4	This act may be referred to as Titan's Law.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 5548 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 5548. Police animals.
10	(a) Illegal to taunt police animalsIt shall be unlawful
11	for a person to intentionally or knowingly taunt, torment,
12	tease, beat, kick or strike a police animal. A person who
13	violates the provisions of this subsection commits a felony of
14	the third degree.
15	(b) Illegal to torture <u>or kill</u> police animalsIt shall be

16 unlawful for a person to [intentionally]:

1 (1) Intentionally or knowingly torture, mutilate, 2 injure, disable, poison or kill a police animal. A person who 3 violates the provisions of this [subsection] paragraph commits a felony of the second degree. 4 (2) Recklessly torture, mutilate, injure, disable, 5 poison or kill a police animal. A person who violates the 6 7 provisions of this paragraph commits a misdemeanor of the first degree. 8 9 (b.1) Illegal to torture or kill police animals during 10 perpetration of felony.--It shall be unlawful for a person to torture, mutilate, injure, disable, poison or kill a police 11 12 animal while engaged as a principal or an accomplice in the perpetration of a felony. A person who violates the provisions 13 14 of this subsection commits a felony of the third degree. 15 (c) Restitution.--In a case in which a defendant is convicted of a violation of subsection (a) [or (b)], (b) or 16 17 (b.1) the defendant shall be ordered to make restitution to the 18 agency or individual owning the animal for veterinary bills, for 19 replacement costs of the animal if it is disabled or killed and for the salary of the animal's handler for the period of time 20 21 the handler's services are lost to the agency. 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
