## AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for 2 methods of voter registration, providing for same-day voter 3 registration and further providing for time and for 4 preparation and distribution of applications. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1321 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 10 § 1321. Methods of voter registration. 11 An individual qualified to register to vote under section 1301(a) (relating to qualifications to register) may apply to 12 13 register as follows: \* \* \* 14 15 (5) Under section 1325.1 (relating to same-day voter 16 registration).
- 17 Section 2. Title 25 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 18 § 1325.1. Same-day voter registration.

- 1 (a) General rule. -- A qualified elector may register on
- 2 <u>election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the</u>
- 3 electoral district in which the individual maintains residence
- 4 by completing and submitting a registration application to the
- 5 judge of elections and providing proof of identification and
- 6 residence.
- 7 (b) Acceptable forms of identification. -- In addition to
- 8 providing a completed voter registration form, an applicant must
- 9 provide a valid form of identification, including any of the
- 10 following government-issued forms of identification:
- 11 (1) A valid identification card issued by the Federal
- 12 <u>Government.</u>
- 13 (2) A valid United States passport.
- 14 (3) A valid United States Armed Forces identification
- 15 card.
- 16 (4) A valid driver's license or identification card
- issued by the Department of Transportation.
- 18 (5) A valid identification card issued by another agency
- of the Commonwealth.
- 20 (c) Procedures for same-day registration. --
- 21 (1) Upon certifying the eligibility of the qualified
- 22 elector, the judge of elections at the polling place shall
- issue a provisional ballot, provided by the county board of
- 24 elections, which is to be completed by the qualified elector
- 25 <u>and sealed in an envelope along with the voter registration</u>
- 26 application.
- 27 (2) Within 10 days of an election, the Department of
- 28 State shall approve or deny a voter registration application
- 29 <u>pursuant to the provisions established in section 1328</u>
- 30 (relating to approval of registration applications).

- 1 (3) The provisional ballot shall not be counted until
- 2 the Department of State has approved the voter registration
- 3 <u>application</u>.
- 4 (4) The qualified elector shall be notified in writing
- 5 by the Department of State as to the approval or denial of a
- 6 <u>voter registration application.</u>
- 7 Section 3. Sections 1326(b) and 1327(c) of Title 25 are
- 8 amended by adding paragraphs to read:
- 9 § 1326. Time.

- 11 (b) Deadlines. -- In the administration of voter registration,
- 12 each commission shall ensure that any applicant who is a
- 13 qualified elector is registered to vote in an election when the
- 14 applicant has met any of the following conditions:

- 16 (3.1) In the case of same-day voter registration under
- 17 section 1325.1 (relating to same-day voter registration), if
- the valid voter registration application of the applicant is
- 19 accepted in the appropriate electoral district by the
- 20 <u>presiding judge of elections.</u>

- 22 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.

- 24 (c) Distribution.--
- 25 \* \* \*
- 26 <u>(7) The secretary shall print and distribute same-day</u>
- 27 <u>voter registration applications to all polling places</u>
- 28 <u>throughout this Commonwealth. Along with the distribution of</u>
- 29 <u>the applications, the secretary shall include instructions to</u>
- 30 inform the applicant of the same-day voter registration

- 4 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
