AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 53825, on that
 2 portion of State Route 1011, also known as Castile Run Road,
 3 over the South Fork Tenmile Creek between Jefferson Township
 4 and Clarksville Borough, Greene County, as the PFC Brent A.
 5 McClellan Memorial Bridge.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. PFC Brent A. McClellan Memorial Bridge.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
 10 follows:

11 (1) Private First Class Brent A. McClellan was born on
 12 March 18, 1944, to Mr. and Mrs. George McClellan, Jr., in
 13 Clarksville, Greene County.

14 (2) In 1963, PFC McClellan graduated from Jefferson-
 15 Morgan High School in Jefferson, Greene County.

16 (3) In May of 1965, PFC McClellan was drafted into the
 17 United States Army to undertake basic training and advanced

1 infantry training.

2 (4) Upon the completion of his training, PFC McClellan
3 was selected to serve in the Honor Guard at Fort Myers,
4 Virginia, near Washington D.C., during which time he was
5 chosen to stand by the grave of President John F. Kennedy.

6 (5) In December of 1965, PFC McClellan was deployed to
7 Vietnam, where he was assigned as an infantryman to the 1st
8 Platoon, B Company, 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry
9 Division, during the Vietnam Conflict.

10 (6) On February 28, 1966, at 21 years of age, PFC
11 McClellan was killed in an ambush by hostile forces during
12 Operation Masher, also known as Operation White Wing, in Binh
13 Dinh Province, South Vietnam.

14 (7) PFC McClellan's awards include the Purple Heart, the
15 National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal,
16 the Vietnam Campaign Medal and the Combat Infantryman Badge.

17 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
18 53825, located on that portion of State Route 1011, also known
19 as Castile Run Road, over the South Fork Tenmile Creek between
20 Jefferson Township and Clarksville Borough, Greene County, is
21 hereby designated as the PFC Brent A. McClellan Memorial Bridge.

22 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
23 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
24 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

25 Section 2. Effective date.

26 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
