## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled "An act relating to counties of the second class and second 2 class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 3 laws relating thereto," in district attorney, assistants and 4 detectives, further providing for filling of vacancies. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 1404 of the act of July 28, 1953 9 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is 10 amended to read: Section 1404. Filling of Vacancies. -- (a) If any vacancy 11 12 shall occur in the office of district attorney, either by death, resignation, removal from office or from the county, suspension 13 of a Pennsylvania law license, disbarment or otherwise, [the 14 15 judges of the court of common pleas shall supply such vacancy by the appointment of a competent person to fill the office during 16 17 the balance of the unexpired term.] the first assistant district 18 attorney shall, upon a showing that the first assistant district

attorney satisfies the requirements of section 1401 of the act

of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code,

- 1 become district attorney and discharge the duties of the
- 2 <u>district attorney until the first Monday in January following</u>
- 3 the next municipal election occurring not less than ninety days
- 4 <u>after the occurrence of the vacancy. If the first assistant</u>
- 5 <u>district attorney is unwilling or unable to serve or does not</u>
- 6 satisfy the requirements of section 1401 of The County Code, the
- 7 judges of the court of common pleas shall fill the vacancy by
- 8 the appointment of a competent person who satisfies the
- 9 requirements of section 1401 of The County Code to fill the
- 10 office until the first Monday in January following the next
- 11 <u>municipal election occurring not less than ninety days after the</u>
- 12 <u>occurrence of the vacancy.</u>
- 13 (b) If a district attorney does not possess an active
- 14 Pennsylvania law license because of the suspension of the law
- 15 <u>license or disbarment while in office, the suspended or</u>
- 16 <u>disbarred district attorney shall regain the office of district</u>
- 17 attorney if the Pennsylvania law license has been reinstated and
- 18 becomes active and if all other qualifications are met and shall
- 19 serve the remainder of the term during which the district
- 20 attorney was suspended or disbarred.
- 21 Section 2. The amendment of section 1404 of the act shall
- 22 apply to vacancies occurring on or after the effective date of
- 23 this section.
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
