8 <u>(i)</u> solely for that official's or employee's own 9 personal use, including telephone message slips, routing 10 slips and other materials that do not have an official 11 purpose[.]; or

<u>(ii) to assist an individual with a disability,</u>
<u>including transcriptions, braille translations or large</u>
<u>print materials.</u>
