## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in equipment standards, further providing for
- 3 unlawful activities.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4107 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 4107. Unlawful activities.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (b.2) Doors.--A vehicle shall be equipped with doors of a
- 11 type used as original equipment. The doors shall open and close
- 12 securely unless the vehicle has been manufactured or modified to
- 13 the extent that there is no roof or side. If a vehicle is
- 14 <u>designed by the manufacturer with removable doors for off-road</u>
- 15 use, the vehicle may be operated on roadways of this
- 16 Commonwealth with doors removed as long as the owner of the
- 17 <u>vehicle notifies the motor vehicle insurer and carries</u>
- 18 acknowledgment of that notification in the vehicle during such

- 1 operation. Notification shall be provided at the time of
- 2 <u>application for motor vehicle insurance coverage and when</u>
- 3 <u>coverage is renewed.</u>

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
