Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for 2 aggravated assault. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2702(a)(2), (b) and (d) of Title 18 of 6 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and 7 8 subsection (c) is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 2702. Aggravated assault. 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated assault if he: 11 * * * 12 13 attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or 14 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the 15 officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in

subsection (c) [or to an employee of an agency, company or

other entity engaged in public transportation,] while in the

- 3 (b) Grading. -- Aggravated assault under subsection (a) (1),
- 4 (2) [and] or (9) is a felony of the first degree. Aggravated
- 5 assault under subsection (a)(3), (4), (5), (6), (7) [and] or (8)
- 6 is a felony of the second degree.
- 7 (c) Officers, employees, etc., enumerated.--The officers,
- 8 agents, employees and other persons referred to in subsection
- 9 (a) shall be as follows:

- 11 (39) An employee of a transportation company.
- 12 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 13 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 subsection:
- 15 "Electric or electronic incapacitation device." A portable
- 16 device which is designed or intended by the manufacturer to be
- 17 used, offensively or defensively, to temporarily immobilize or
- 18 incapacitate persons by means of electric pulse or current,
- 19 including devices operated by means of carbon dioxide
- 20 propellant. The term does not include cattle prods, electric
- 21 fences or other electric devices when used in agricultural,
- 22 animal husbandry or food production activities.
- "Emergency medical services personnel." The term includes,
- 24 but is not limited to, doctors, residents, interns, registered
- 25 nurses, licensed practical nurses, nurse aides, ambulance
- 26 attendants and operators, paramedics, emergency medical
- 27 technicians and members of a hospital security force while
- 28 working within the scope of their employment.
- 29 "Public passenger transportation." Transportation within
- 30 designated areas of a municipality or other built-up place

- 1 provided to the general public for compensation by a
- 2 transportation company, including, but not limited to, subways,
- 3 <u>buses, trolleys and trackless trolleys. The term shall not</u>
- 4 <u>include school buses, charter or sightseeing services, taxicabs</u>
- 5 <u>or passenger railroad passenger cars.</u>
- 6 "Transportation company." A publicly or privately owned
- 7 <u>entity that renders public passenger transportation service.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
