A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4	Urging the Congress of the United States to provide funding and financial support to live performance venues and arts-related nonprofit organizations especially distressed by the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
5	WHEREAS, Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic affecting the
6	United States, live performance venues and arts-related
7	nonprofit organizations face unprecedented financial challenges,
8	uncertainty and prolonged closure; and
9	WHEREAS, Live performance venues, especially small
10	independently owned venues, were the first to close due to the
11	pandemic and are expected to be the last to reopen as they
12	require the gathering of large numbers of people; and
13	WHEREAS, Cancellation of events and the uncertain future of
14	the live performance industry has a broader impact not only on
15	the venue itself, but also on the surrounding community
16	negatively impacted by income lost due to the absence of event
17	attendees; and

WHEREAS, Live performance venues and arts-related nonprofit
organizations have been touted as the industries most affected
by the COVID-19 pandemic; and
WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to 340 live performance

5 venues and 15 arts-related nonprofit organizations; and 6 WHEREAS, Arts and live performance venues are forced to shut 7 for the health and safety of the public; and

8 WHEREAS, We must support arts and live performance venues to 9 ensure that they will still be around postpandemic for the 10 education and entertainment of all; and

11 WHEREAS, Federal assistance and support to these entities is 12 needed, including Senator Cornyn's Senate Bill 4258,

13 establishing the Save Our Stage or SOS Act; and

14 WHEREAS, We acknowledge that performance venues and arts-15 related nonprofit organizations are an important factor in the education and entertainment of the residents of this 16 Commonwealth, and having been extraordinarily impacted by the 17 18 COVID-19 pandemic they are deserving of financial aid and 19 support during these extraordinary times; therefore be it 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United 21 States to provide funding and financial support to live 22 23 performance venues and arts-related nonprofit organizations 24 especially distressed by the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
