A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of October 2018 as "Dyslexia Awareness 1 Month" in Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, Developmental reading disorder, or dyslexia, is a 3 4 language-based learning disability that occurs when there is a problem in areas of the brain that help interpret language; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Dyslexia's symptoms include slow or inaccurate 7 reading, poor spelling, poor writing or mixing up similar words; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, Problems experienced by people with dyslexia may 10 include: 11 confusing letters or having difficulty learning the 12 sounds that go with letters; 13 having trouble learning how to speak, recognizing 14 words or determining the meaning of a simple sentence; and 15 having trouble processing the sounds of language, 16 such as rhyming; 17 and 18 WHEREAS, Dyslexia can include disorganization of written and

- 1 spoken language or struggles in comprehending and concentrating
- 2 on longer reading assignments; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Dyslexia may also include difficulty in correctly
- 4 performing math operations, memorizing number facts or learning
- 5 a foreign language; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dyslexia is a specific information processing
- 7 problem that does not interfere with one's ability to think or
- 8 understand complex ideas; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dyslexia is not caused by a lack of desire to learn
- 10 and affects people of all backgrounds and intellectual levels,
- 11 with the majority of individuals being of normal intelligence
- 12 and many being above average in intelligence; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Students with dyslexia are likely to struggle with
- 14 many aspects of academic learning, are at a higher risk of
- 15 dropping out of school entirely and often go for years without
- 16 being properly diagnosed; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Aside from problems in school, an individual with
- 18 dyslexia can experience a loss of self-esteem and general
- 19 reading problems that may persist into adulthood, which can
- 20 affect the individual's job performance; and
- 21 WHEREAS, According to the International Dyslexia Association,
- 22 approximately 85% of students classified as having a primary
- 23 learning disability have difficulty in reading and language
- 24 processing; and
- 25 WHEREAS, The number of people having some symptoms of
- 26 dyslexia is much higher, perhaps as much as 15% to 20% of the
- 27 entire United States population; and
- 28 WHEREAS, There is much hope for students who are correctly
- 29 diagnosed with this disorder, as they can successfully learn
- 30 with appropriate teaching methods; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The earlier that dyslexia is diagnosed, the better
- 2 it is for the student; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Dyslexia is a disorder that often manifests among
- 4 members of the same family; and
- 5 WHEREAS, While dyslexia affects individuals throughout their
- 6 lives, its impact can change at different stages of life; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Dyslexia is an often misunderstood language-based
- 8 disability, and a large percentage of residents of this
- 9 Commonwealth experience one or more symptoms of this disorder;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 12 month of October 2018 as "Dyslexia Awareness Month" in
- 13 Pennsylvania.
