A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of October 6 through 14, 2014, as "Credit  
2 Union Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Credit unions are individual, independent  
4 cooperatives founded by people working together toward economic  
5 advancement and uniting people who seek a way to improve their  
6 future; and

7 WHEREAS, Credit unions call for the pooling of personal  
8 resources and leadership abilities for the good of the  
9 cooperative, provide low-cost financial services to their  
10 members, encourage a regular habit of saving so those in need  
11 may borrow and foster the desire to repay loans so members may  
12 have access to credit when it is required; and

13 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania currently has more than 400 credit  
14 unions empowering people to improve their economic situations by

1 serving the financial needs of in excess of 3,000,000 members,  
2 associated through international, regional, State and local  
3 organizations sharing the same commitment to serving credit  
4 union members; and

5 WHEREAS, Credit unions encourage and sponsor activities to  
6 promote the charitable acts of their members; and

7 WHEREAS, The unselfish efforts of volunteers organized  
8 through credit unions have benefited many worthwhile causes  
9 throughout this Commonwealth and beyond; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
11 week of October 6 through 14, 2014, as "Credit Union Week" in  
12 Pennsylvania; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to  
14 the Pennsylvania Credit Union Association.
