A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of November 2016 as "American Music Month"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Music, often described as the universal language, is
4 one of the great arts and its value is recognized as a source of
5 enrichment in our lives; and

6 WHEREAS, The annual Parade of American Music, sponsored by
7 the National Federation of Music Clubs, is featured throughout
8 the month of November to give due recognition to America's music
9 traditions and to encourage and support worthy United States
10 composers; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Federation of Music Clubs is a
12 component part of the National Federation of Music Clubs and
13 joins in the parade with its notable purposes; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the

1 month of November 2016 as "American Music Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.
