- 1 Honoring the life and service of Chief Justice Ronald D.
 - Castille upon his retirement from the Supreme Court of
- 3 Pennsylvania.

- 4 WHEREAS, Chief Justice Ronald D. Castille has served the
- 5 citizens of the nation and of the Commonwealth with distinction
- 6 and honor as a Marine, prosecutor, and a member of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Supreme Court since 1993, and as Chief Justice
- 8 since 2008; and
- 9 WHEREAS, As Chief Justice, he has worked tirelessly,
- 10 modernizing the Pennsylvania court system, increasing the
- 11 availability of legal assistance for the poor and the indigent,
- 12 assisting judges in their adherence to the highest standards of
- 13 judicial and personal conduct by adopting a new Code of Judicial
- 14 Conduct, and ensuring, through his leadership and personal
- 15 example, the independence of the Judiciary and nonpartisanship

- 1 of its Highest Court; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Prior to his election to the Supreme Court, he
- 3 faithfully served the citizens of Philadelphia for nearly twenty
- 4 years in the District Attorney's Office, including four as the
- 5 District Attorney; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Prior to his service in this Commonwealth, he served
- 7 his country with extraordinary bravery as a First Lieutenant in
- 8 the United States Marine Corps, and as a Rifle Platoon Commander
- 9 in Vietnam; and
- 10 WHEREAS, His life and career have been marked throughout by
- 11 excellence, which has been evidenced in part by the many honors
- 12 and awards bestowed upon him; that among these are two Purple
- 13 Heart Medals, a Bronze Star Medal, the Pennsylvania Legal Aid
- 14 Network Excellence Award, the Philadelphia Bar Association
- 15 William J. Brennan Distinguished Jurist Award, the Pennsylvania
- 16 Bar Association Judge of the Year Award, the Military Order of
- 17 World Wars Patrick Henry Award for Patriotic Achievement, the
- 18 Philadelphia Vietnam Veterans Dedicated Service Award, the
- 19 National Disabled American Veterans Outstanding Disabled Veteran
- 20 of the Year Award, and the National District Attorneys
- 21 Association President's Award for Outstanding Service; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Having reached the age of retirement under Article V
- 23 of the Pennsylvania Constitution, Chief Justice Ronald D.
- 24 Castille shall be retired from the bench of the Supreme Court
- 25 where he has served for twenty-one years, faithfully applying
- 26 the Constitution of this Commonwealth and the laws that govern
- 27 our society; therefore be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorates the
- 29 distinguished life and career of the Honorable Chief Justice
- 30 Ronald D. Castille, thanks him for his service, and extends its
