## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of October 2016 as "Check Your Health Insurance Coverage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Yearly open enrollment periods for commercial health
- 4 care plans typically begin in October or November, when
- 5 consumers can enroll in a new health insurance plan or renew an
- 6 existing plan; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Consumers often choose a health care plan based on
- 8 whether their provider is in-network, coverage of a particular
- 9 prescription and cost-sharing; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Consumers expect to have access to the providers,
- 11 services and medications that meet their individual medical
- 12 needs throughout the plan year; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Ensuring that a plan meets a patient's needs is
- 14 particularly important for patients with certain chronic
- 15 conditions, many of whom have been through years of trial and
- 16 error with their physicians to find the therapy that is the most
- 17 effective with the least amount of side effects; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Cost-sharing associated formulary placement impacts
- 2 the financial burden on enrollees, and treatment interruptions
- 3 can negatively impact an individual's health; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Reminding consumers to review their health insurance
- 5 plans in October ensures that their coverage is consistent with
- 6 their medical and financial needs; and
- 7 WHEREAS, During open enrollment, consumers with inadequate
- 8 coverage may select a health care plan that covers the
- 9 medications they need at a level they can afford from the
- 10 provider they trust; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Health insurers throughout this Commonwealth provide
- 12 education materials during the month of October to remind
- 13 consumers to "Check Your Health Insurance Coverage" before
- 14 renewing the plan or enrolling in a new plan; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 16 month of October 2016 as "Check Your Health Insurance Coverage
- 17 Month" in Pennsylvania.
