A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of November 11 through 17, 2018, as
- "Diabetes and Cardiovascular Disease Awareness Week" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, Approximately 1.4 million Pennsylvanians have
- 5 diabetes, a chronic condition that occurs when the body does not
- 6 properly produce or use the hormone insulin that regulates blood
- 7 sugar; and
- 8 WHEREAS, An additional 3.5 million Pennsylvanians have
- 9 prediabetes, which is an elevated blood sugar level not yet high
- 10 enough to be diagnosed as diabetes; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Type 2 diabetes is the most common type of diabetes,
- 12 representing an estimated 90% to 95% of all diagnosed adult
- 13 diabetes cases in the United States; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Individuals with type 2 diabetes have a two to four

- 1 times greater risk of developing cardiovascular disease; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Cardiovascular disease, the term used to define
- 3 problems with the heart and blood vessels, including heart
- 4 attacks, heart failure and strokes, is the leading cause of
- 5 death associated with diabetes due to complications associated
- 6 with diabetes, including high blood sugar, high blood pressure
- 7 and obesity; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Cardiovascular disease accounts for 68% of deaths in
- 9 individuals with type 2 diabetes in the United States; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Diabetes treatment costs an estimated \$12.9 billion
- 11 in Pennsylvania each year, and cardiovascular disease accounts
- 12 for an estimated 28% of costs for treating diabetes patients;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, Findings from a recent study revealed that 52% of
- 15 adults living with type 2 diabetes are unaware that they are at
- 16 an increased risk of cardiovascular disease; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Appropriate awareness and education about the
- 18 cardiovascular risks associated with diabetes can effectively
- 19 improve outcomes and reduce the overall financial burden of the
- 20 illness; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The Department of Health and other relevant partners
- 22 seek to promote awareness, education and action related to
- 23 diabetes and the link to cardiovascular disease; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The month of November is "American Diabetes Month";
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 27 week of November 11 through 17, 2018, as "Diabetes and
- 28 Cardiovascular Disease Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania; and be
- 29 it further
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage others

- 1 to promote education and awareness of the connection between
- 2 diabetes and cardiovascular disease.
