A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing November 3, 2018, as "One Health Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, One Health is the concept that the health of humans,
- 4 animals, plants and the environment are closely linked; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "One Health Day" is celebrated around the globe to
- 6 highlight, promote and raise awareness about a One Health
- 7 approach to address complex health problems confronting humans,
- 8 animals, plants and the environment; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is committed to the health, safety
- 10 and well-being of all Pennsylvanians, the health and well-being
- 11 of domestic animals and free-ranging wild animals in this
- 12 Commonwealth and the health of the environment; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Our economy is dependent on healthy humans, animals,
- 14 plants and the environment; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Infectious diseases have the potential to
- 16 significantly harm this Commonwealth's economic and social well-

- 2 WHEREAS, Preventing infectious and vector-borne diseases and
- 3 limiting their spread from the environment to animals and
- 4 eventually to humans is both environmentally responsible and
- 5 economically beneficial; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The best health for humans, animals, plants and the
- 7 environment can only be achieved through the collaborative
- 8 efforts of multiple disciplines and organizations working
- 9 locally, regionally, nationally and globally; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The American Medical Association, American Nurses
- 11 Association, American Public Health Association, American
- 12 Veterinary Medical Association, Centers for Disease Control and
- 13 Prevention, United States Department of Agriculture and its
- 14 Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, World Health
- 15 Organization and other partners acknowledge and encourage
- 16 increased collaboration of disciplines and organizations to
- 17 achieve the best health for humans, animals, plants and the
- 18 environment; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The goal of "One Health Day" is to build global
- 20 attention to human, animal, plant and environmental health
- 21 challenges and promote collaborative approaches; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has established a One Health Task
- 23 Force that is diligently working to broaden the collaborative
- 24 actions of Commonwealth agencies and our partners concerned with
- 25 attaining optimal health for humans, animals, plants and the
- 26 environment; therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 28 November 3, 2018, as "One Health Day" in Pennsylvania and join
- 29 other states and countries in celebrating "One Health Day."
