A RESOLUTION

- Urging the Department of Agriculture and the Department of 1
- Education to collaborate on conducting a Statewide study of 2
- school cafeteria services provided to every school district. 3
- 4 WHEREAS, Federal law requires that school kitchens be
- inspected twice per year; and 5
- 6 WHEREAS, The Department of Agriculture conducts and regulates
- 7 inspections for restaurants and schools and provides inspection
- 8 reports on food safety on its website; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A facility may have a few violations and still be
- 10 considered in compliance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Additionally, the Department of Education's Food and
- Nutrition Division assists school districts with resources to 12
- provide students with quality meals; and 13
- 14 WHEREAS, Some school districts may struggle with serving
- 15 quality and healthy meal portions which has an impact on the
- 16 health and well-being of students; and
- 17 WHEREAS, It is imperative that each school district ensures
- that each student receives quality meals and portions necessary 18

- 1 for their best academic performance; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 3 Department of Agriculture and the Department of Education to
- 4 collaborate on conducting a Statewide study of school cafeteria
- 5 services provided to every school district; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the study shall:
- 7 (1) set standards for school meal quality and quantity,
- 8 including portion size, based on grade or age level;
- 9 (2) determine the nutritional and caloric content of
- 10 breakfast and lunch meals served at public schools in this
- 11 Commonwealth in comparison to school meal quality and
- 12 quantity standards;
- 13 (3) evaluate the costs for each school district to
- 14 prepare meals and the costs charged to students for those
- meals; and
- 16 (4) make recommendations of legislation or legislative
- 17 action required to ensure that all school districts meet
- school meal nutrition and quality standards;
- 19 and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the Department of Agriculture and the
- 21 Department of Education issue a report with their findings and
- 22 recommendations to the General Assembly and post the study on
- 23 the departments' publicly accessible Internet websites within
- 24 one year of the adoption of this resolution.
